The book, known as *The Red Book* because of its red cover, is a comprehensive collection of many of the same referral services available through United Way 2-1-1's phone and internet system. It provides listings of resources to assist people seeking help with a variety of needs, such as food, shelter, employment, low-to-no-cost health, mental health, dental care and volunteer opportunities. It is be a useful tool for everyone, but has been particularly helpful for case managers, church leaders, school counselors and correctional facilities.

United Way of Salt Lake encourages the public to take advantage of this opportunity now since *The Red Book* is only published once every two years.
