Supplies will be collected now through August 31, then stuffed into backpacks and delivered to United Way Community Schools and Neighborhood Centers serving low-income children and families in the community. Hundreds of volunteers will stuff supplies into backpacks and deliver them on September 10, 2015 during the organization's 23<sup>rd</sup> annual *Day of Caring* event.
