Our Community

Partners work with United Way of Salt Lake in the neighborhood surrounding the Davis Community Learning Center at Wasatch Elementary, encompassing approximately 13,000 residents. Thirty-seven percent of this population is youth under age 18, and 61 percent of youth live in families whose incomes are at or near the poverty level. While 83 percent of the population is Caucasian, other ethnicities, primarily Hispanic, are also represented, and 15 percent of families speak a language other than English.

Promise Clearfield is a partnership of school and community organizations working together to provide a network of social and support services to youth, families, and community members.

Our Promise

Our promise is to promote the value of learning, self-worth among students and adults in the community and provide a network of services to facilitate quality performance among students, families, and community members and enhance their cohesive productive and responsible participation in society. Successful Children, Thriving Families, Vibrant Communities.

Our Goals

1. 10 percent increase of all non-proficient Wasatch Elementary students will be proficient
2. Student Education Plan (parent/teacher conferences) attendance is 100 percent
3. Attendance for K-2 grades increases to 95 percent; 3-6 grades increases to 97 percent
4. Individuals have access to English as a Second Language instruction and increase level gains
5. All children and adults have increased access to mental health services
6. Eighty percent of adults and 94 percent of children have a regular place for medical care, other than the ER
7. Increase in flu shots administered at Wasatch Elementary by 25 percent


