Our Community

At Granger Elementary, United Way of Salt Lake partners with many organizations to provide programs and resources for families. Granger Elementary is the largest elementary school in the Granite School District, with more than 1000 students. It serves children K-6 and offers multiple half day and evening preschool classes. The student body at Granger is exceedingly diverse, 82 percent are ethnic minority, and 75 percent do not speak English as their primary language. In addition, 81 percent qualify for free and reduced lunch. Because of language, income, and other barriers, 46 percent of kids are not achieving on grade level in language arts, and 41 percent are behind in math.

The Granger Neighborhood Center offers:

- A before and afterschool program to more than 200 students, which includes meals
- Adult English classes for parents
- Direct health insurance enrollment assistance
- A mobile health clinic for uninsured children and families
- Flu shots and immunizations
- College savings accounts and financial literacy
- Preschool

Promise Partners focus their efforts on resources families need to thrive and develop a cradle to career pipeline to ensure children are on track to succeed academically.
